Marian Podstawka is a full professor at the Institute of Agricultural and Food Economics – National Research Institute and the Warsaw University of Life Sciences. Once again, he has been elected as a member of the Committee on Economic Sciences of the Polish Academy of Sciences for 2020-2023. From 1993 to 1998, he was the Deputy Dean of the Faculty of Economics and Agriculture at the Warsaw University of Life Sciences, and from 1999 to 2005, he was the Dean of the said Faculty. His scientific research and publishing interests focus on rural development and agriculture, agricultural economy, and finance in agribusiness. His scientific achievements include nearly 300 scientific works, including two editions of the textbook "Finance" (Publishing House: PWN). The professor served and continues to serve as an expert among others at the Agricultural Social Insurance Fund, the Social Insurance Institution, the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development, at the National Agricultural Support Center, as well as at the European Commission. He was the manager and applicant of many research projects. He was the thesis supervisor of 19 students who obtained the PhD degree and about 2,000 students who obtained the MSc and BSc degrees. In his spare time, the professor is devoted to his two passions: beekeeping and poetry.
