

Lukasz Ambroziak, PhD, DSc, is a professor of the Institute of Agricultural and Food Economics – National Research Institute (IAFE-NRI). He has been working at the IAFE-NRI since March 1, 2013 (initially as an assistant, later as an assistant professor and as a professor) in the Department of Agribusiness and Bioeconomy Economics (previously, until December 31, 2019, in the Department of the Food Industry). From 2007 to 2018, he worked at the Institute of Market, Consumption, and Business Cycle Research, and since September 2018, he has been employed at the Polish Economic Institute (currently on unpaid leave). In 2013, he obtained a PhD degree in economics from the Collegium of World Economy at the Warsaw School of Economics, and in 2024, he obtained a postdoctoral degree in social sciences in the discipline of economics and finance at the IAFE-NRI.

His research interests include: international economics, foreign direct investment, foreign trade (including trade measured by value added), global value chains, competitive position in foreign trade in agri-food products, the impact of trade policy instruments on trade changes. He is the author or co-author of more than 100 scientific publications – monographs, chapters in monographs and articles published in Polish and international journals, dozens of expert reports for government administration and food sector entities, and author of many popular scientific publications. He lectures on agribusiness economics in postgraduate studies at the IAFE-NRI. He pays great attention to the popularization of knowledge and research results.
