Habilitated doctor of social sciences in the discipline of economics and finance. He is a Professor at the Department of Farm and Horticultural Economics of the Institute of Agricultural and Food Economics – National Research Institute. He has been affiliated with IAFE-NRI since 2006. Since 2023, he has served as the Head of the Department of Farm and Horticultural Economics. In 2025, he was awarded the post-doctoral degree in the field of social sciences, in the discipline of Economics and Finance, at IAFE-NRI. Since 2025, he has been an Institute Professor at the Department of Farm and Horticultural Economics. Member of the Polish Economic Society.

His research focuses on the competitiveness of farms with differing environmental and climate impacts, regarding instruments of the European Union's Common Agricultural Policy. His work is particularly influenced by the principles of institutional economics. He is the author and co-author of numerous national and international scientific publications, as well as expert reports prepared for public administration in the field of agricultural economics. In recent years, he has led research projects and research tasks concerning, among other topics, the design of direct payment schemes for Polish agriculture under the CAP. He is actively involved in both national and international research projects.

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
