Affiliated with the Poznań University of Life Sciences since 1999. After completing his PhD, he was appointed Assistant Professor in 2003 and subsequently promoted to the position of University Professor following the habilitation degree in economic sciences in the discipline of economics at the Institute of Agricultural and Food Economics – National Research Institute in Warsaw.

His research focuses on the economics of European integration in the context of the implementation of the European Union's Common Agricultural Policy, as well as the evaluation of EU's and national agricultural support programmes.

Author and co-author of more than 100 publications and 25 expert reports, prepared primarily for the Polish Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development. He has served as the principal investigator of two research projects and has participated in nearly 200 scientific conferences and seminars. He is the founder and academic supervisor of the Student Scientific Association of Agribusiness Economists and has supervised 70 bachelor's theses, 50 master's theses, and two doctoral dissertations. He lectures at the Poznań University of Life Sciences as well as at the Czech University of Life Sciences Prague, Qinghai Minzu University in Xining, and Kozybayev North Kazakhstan University in Petropavl. He is a member of numerous scientific organisations, working groups, and editorial and advisory boards of academic publications.

In cooperation with the Polish Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development, including as a member of evaluation teams, he contributed to the *Ex-ante Evaluation of the Rural Development Programme 2014–2020* and the *Ex-ante Evaluation of the Common Agricultural Policy Strategic Plan 2021–2027*. In May 2026, he was appointed by the Polish Minister of Agriculture and Rural Development to the Working Group on Common Agricultural Policy Programming. As part of his work on the European Union's Common Agricultural Policy, he collaborates with the European Parliament and the European Commission. He served as an expert panellist during the public hearing entitled “Evolution of the Performance Framework in the Common Agricultural Policy” of the European Parliament's Committee on Agriculture and Rural Development. He is also a researcher in the project “Study on the Green Architecture Tools to Improve Environmental Outcomes”, commissioned by the Directorate-General for Agriculture and Rural Development of the European Commission.
