Renata Grochowska, PhD, DSc, is a professor of the Institute of Agricultural and Food Economics – National Research Institute (IAFE – NRI). In the past, she worked as a senior researcher in the Institute of Genetics and Animal Breeding of the Polish Academy of Sciences (1986-2003), then as a counselor at the Office of the Committee for European Integration (2000-2009) and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (2010) in Warsaw. She has two and a half years of experience as a seconded national expert of the European Commission, the Directorate-General for Agriculture and Rural Development in Brussels. Since 2011, she has been working as a professor of the IAFE – NRI.

Her main activities cover the development of the agricultural sector in the context of global and national settings; the assessment of the Common Agricultural Policy impact on the EU and the Polish food industry in medium- and long-term perspectives; the monitoring of the EU decision-making process in the range of the Common Agricultural Policy and other policies linked to the CAP; and the monitoring of the EU budget reforms.

Ms. Grochowska was a leader and co-coordinator of many working groups set up for ministerial purposes, for example, for the Common Agricultural Policy's reforms. On the scientific ground, she has been involved in projects on agricultural and rural development strategies in Europe and other regions under Multi-Annual Programs of the IAFE – NRI. She has also worked as a lecturer at the university (subject: development of agriculture and rural areas in the UE and Poland).
